# THE AMAZING THINGS OF THE LORD

### Lesson Text: Exodus 33:12-23

"And he said, Thou canst not see my face: for there shall no man see me, and live" (Exodus 33:20).



BIG IDEA: God promises to be with Israel so that His glory will be known.

EXODUS 33:12 And Moses said unto the LORD, See, thou sayest unto me, Bring up this people: and thou hast not let me know whom thou wilt send with me. Yet thou hast said, I know thee by name, and thou hast also found grace in my sight.

- 13 Now therefore, I pray thee, if I have found grace in thy sight, shew me now thy way, that I may know thee, that I may find grace in thy sight: and consider that this nation is thy people.
- 14 And he said, My presence shall go with thee, and I will give thee rest.
- 15 And he said unto him, If thy presence go not with me, carry us not up hence.
- 16 For wherein shall it be known here that I and thy people have found grace in thy sight? is it not in that thou goest with us? so shall we be separated, I and thy people, from all the people that are upon the face of the earth.
  - 17 And the LORD said unto Moses, I will

do this thing also that thou hast spoken: for thou hast found grace in my sight, and I know thee by name.

- 18 And he said, I beseech thee, shew me thy glory.

Before God told Moses His name, the people of Israel sinned by worshipping a golden calf. God threatened to leave the Israelites. The people repented of their sins, and Moses begged God not to abandon His people. The people of God did not want to have the presence of God taken away from them.

God will never leave His children. He forgives when they repent. When people repent, they turn away from sin. They turn from their wicked ways.

When you repent of your sins, you admit what you did was wrong and turn away from doing it again. When you agree with God that what you did was wrong, you shouldn't keep doing the same thing over and over.

Moses was God's friend. Moses had seen God do many miracles (see chapters 11-14)! Friends often talk face-to-face. When God talked with Moses, it was not face-to-face, however.
