Our picture shows a king and a priest. They were leaders who should have helped people obey God's rules. But that is not what they were doing. The kings and priests were sinning. They did not respect God. They told lies and were mean to poor people. The sinful leaders made God's people sin too.

Bible Lesson—Ezekiel 33:12-20

Our picture shows some people who are complaining about God. They got angry because they thought God was not being fair.

God told the prophet Ezekiel to give them a message. He said to tell the people that they were the ones who were not being fair. God is fair. He always does what is right.

God punishes people when they sin. That is fair, because people who break God's rules deserve to be punished. God forgives people when they turn to Him and stop sinning. He does not punish them unfairly.

Some people thought that they should not be punished because they had done some good things. But now they were sinning. He was being fair when He punished them. Sin causes death. It is sad but true. Sin separates people from God. Sin keeps people from going to heaven to be with God.

But God gave His people a promise. He said that people do not have to die. God promised to forgive people who are sorry for their sin and choose to follow Him.
